# **Mandatory Earthquake Kits**

Dear Parents,

The mandatory earthquake kits are due the first day of school.

We encourage you to take the time and fulfill this responsibility for the sake of your child/ren.

In the event of an earthquake, please DO NOT phone the school.

Our evacuation procedure will be conducted in an orderly manner.

We will follow these steps:

1. Parents will be notified that the school is being evacuated through the Blackboard Connect Automated message service which will enable us to send the message and reach parents within minutes.

**NOTE:** If telephone service is interrupted, parents may assume that the following procedures for evacuation are already in effect and being followed:

2. Children will be brought by their teacher to the “big field” where roll will be taken. Then, they will be placed in “Family Groups.” Children will be released **ONLY** to their parent/guardian or another adult designated by the parent/guardian on their emergency forms.
3. Drivers are to pick up children at the Release Center between the Sacred Heart Room and Teachers’ Lounge area.
4. Children will be sent home in their regular carpools or with their own parents.
5. Unless the school has received explicit written instructions to the contrary, children who normally walk or bike will not be allowed to do so in an emergency evacuation. Be assured the school has food and water, blankets, first aid kits, etc. available for your child and that all teachers are trained in First Aid and CPR.

All parents will be required to organize a kit for each child with the following items:

1. A large ziplock bag with the child’s name and grade on a piece of tape.
2. 1 Emergency thermal blanket (approx.cost \$2.30), may be purchased at Target.
3. Emergency card with medical alerts, blood type, physician and emergency pick up person.
4. A picture of their family and comforting note.
5. 3 cans of juice or packaged drinks
6. 1 plastic spoon
7. 1 pack of wipes
8. Dixie Cups
9. 2 canned goods, (fruit, Vienna sausage, tuna)

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
